Declaration of an Active RN Multistate License as the Underlying Credential for a Washington State ARNP

In accordance with the <u>Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC)</u>, nurses with an active multistate registered nurse (RN) or licensed practical nurse license (LPN) in another state can practice in Washington state. If you hold an active advanced registered nurse practitioner (ARNP) license in Washington state and hold an active RN multistate license, the RN multistate license is recognized as an approved underlying RN license and you will not need to renew your Washington state RN license.

Please complete the form below to indicate where the active RN mulitstate license is held, the multistate license number, and acknowledgment that you will not be renewing your Washington state RN license.

I declare that I hold an active RN multistate license in another state and will not be renewing my Washington state RN license. I declare that my primary state of residence (PSOR) is not Washington state and my PSOR is held in another participating NLC state in which I hold an active multistate license. I am requesting for my Washington state RN license status to reflect "Expired WA- Active MSL".

I understand that if I change my PSOR to Washington state, it is my responsibility to notify the board of nursing where the multistate license is active. I also understand that it is my responsibility to either maintain an active MSL in another state or hold an active Washington single state or multistate license as an underlying requirement of my active Washington state ARNP license. If I do not hold an active underlying RN license, my Washington state ARNP license becomes inoperable per WAC 246-840-360.
